


EVA INTERNATIONAL ART GALLERY participates in this magnificent Contemporary Art Fair every year and as always, we are very delighted to be here also this year.













Anni Kuismin








Mother Russia and her child, forged bronze, $14 \text{cm} \times 12 \text{cm} \times 12 \text{cm}$, 2022

Unknown pleasures, thread on acoustic element, $60 \text{cm} \times 60 \text{cm}$, 2023




Birgit Walander



Birgit Walander









Maria Maksakova



Matti Paatelainen








Suutarin Mökki, öljy kankaalle, 70cm x 50cm, 2000

Inner Space Voyage' from the series Hello, Sun in My Face, acrylic on canvas, 30cm x 30cm, 2023




Petra Kinnunen


Petronella Lukka


Mothers Blessing, oil on linen, 63cm x 53cm, 2023
